HOW IT WORKS

Once you are officially registered with us, you will be matched with a student at the beginning of the programme who you will mentor over a period of 12 weeks. There is an expectation of approximately 4 mentoring sessions (a handbook is provided to guide sessions) and these sessions can be online or face to face.

THE ROLE OF A MENTOR

The role of the mentor is to guide the student through their current employability challenges, support them to set goals and to do this while sharing experiences that will develop the student. We are looking for mentors with a breadth of life experience to share with our students, as well as support them with their CV's, finding opportunities, utilising LinkedIn and preparing confidently for interviews!
